Forecasts

Oklahoma is known for quickchanging weather patterns. This makes predicting weather difficult, and forecasts are often reviewed, discussed and argued. Will it rain? How much? Will it freeze? When is the cold front coming?

Creating forecasts

To create a forecast, meteorologists look at a large amount of information ranging from observations, weather balloons, radar, satellite and computer models. They use this information to produce forecasts, which could be for 30 minutes into the future or up to 8 days. "Outlooks" show long range weather trends weeks or months into the future.

Because of the uncertainty of Oklahoma weather, forecasts offer a useful way to plan activities. The Mesonet website offers a number of helpful, expert forecasts and packages them into one easy-to-use site.


Forecast products

The Mesonet website's "**Forecast**" tab at www.mesonet.org features the National Weather Service (NWS) "**Forecast at a Glance**" which presents a condensed forecast for five days and nights.


Below the Forecast at a Glance is a link to the NWS "**complete forecast**" and Hourly Forecast "**graph**" or "**table**". Forecast weather variables are graphed over time so you can easily see trends and changes. This product allows you to turn off or back on the weather variables that are relevant to you.

Graphicasts, from the NWS forecast office, give you a regional picture of the most important weather story that is happening. It could be severe weather, wild fires, winter weather or simply a cold or warm front.

Our Story The Oklahoma Mesonet is a world-class network of environmental monitoring stations. The network was designed and implemented by scientists at the University of Oklahoma (OU) and at Oklahoma State University (OSU).

The Oklahoma Mesonet consists of 120 automated stations covering Oklahoma. There is at least one Mesonet station in each of Oklahoma's 77 counties.

At each site, the environment is measured by a set of instruments located on or near a 10-meter-tall tower. The measurements are packaged into "observations" every 5 minutes, then the observations are transmitted to a central facility every 5 minutes, 24 hours per day year-round.
